Do not attempt to energize anything other than the lighting track luminaires on the track.

There are no user servicable parts inside. Opening unit will void warranty.

## **INSTRUCTIONS**

To install the fixture to the track:

- Step 1) Turn off main power (Fig. 1)
- Step 2) Select colour temperature before installing to slider. (Fig. 2)
- Step 3) Pull back the adapter latch (Fig. 3)
- Step 4) Insert the contact assembly into the track (Fig. 3)
- Step 5) Rotate the fixture neck 90° so the contacts on the fixture align with the contacts on the track (Fig. 3)
- Step 6) Release the adapter latch allowing the fixture to lock into position (Fig. 3)
- Step 7) Turn the track head connector to "ON" (Fig. 4)
- Step 8) Turn on main power (Fig. 5)

## To remove the fixture:

- Step 1) Turn the track head connector to "OFF" (Fig. 4)
- Step 2) Slide the adapter latch down until latch is clear of the track channel opening (Fig. 3)
- Step 3) Twist the fixture neck and turn (90°) until the contact assembly is free (Fig. 3)
- Step 4) Remove fixture from track (Fig. 3)
